Criticism was hurled at the board, which has three new members, when public comment on non-agenda items was not invited until the end of the Jan. 4 meeting. At this week's meeting, board members solidified their policy:

Public comment will be invited at both the beginning (30 minutes) and at the end of every meeting on non-agenda items. Additionally, citizens will be invited to comment on nearly every agenda item. The board also will not impose a time limit on citizens but asks that citizens be mindful of time and redundancy.
